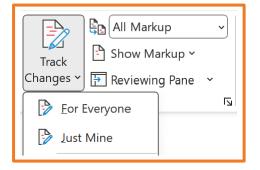

The Contractor will be required to work with councils to ensure that all goods and services delivered under the contract are delivered to an appropriate standard and quality.



With regards to goods supplied under this contract, they must be fit for purpose and intended use, of high quality and complying or exceeding relevant Australian Standards. With regards to services, the installation / erection / building of the goods should be such that they are fit for purpose and intended use, to pass relevant inspections, complying or exceeding with relevant Australian Standards and to be completed within agreed timeframes.

The Contractor will be required to work with councils to ensure that all goods and services delivered under orders issued under the Standing Offer Deed are delivered to an appropriate standard and quality.

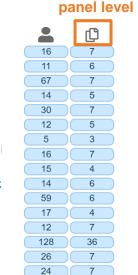

The LGP Category Manager will review the information provided to assess the risk profile of the procurement and determine if council can proceed under the contract.

This confirmation is sent via email in the form of a Letter of Acknowledgement.

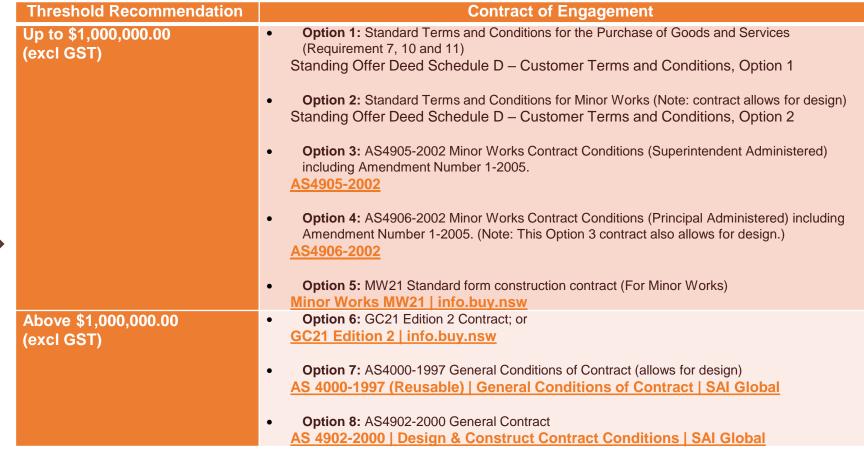
LGP213-3 Bitumen, Emulsions, & Asphalt Schedule D – Contract Options

The terms and conditions applicable to the Customer Contract are selected according to the category of work being undertaken.

Where a specific requirement warrants a higher level of terms and conditions, council may nominate an alternate contract from those in Schedule D of the Standing Offer Deed.



This example shows those available for LGP213-3 Bitumen, Emulsions, & Asphalt.



Determining which contract is preferred, is to be based on Council's needs and the project at hand. Council will nominate the chosen option at time of uploading its RfQ in VendorPanel.



LGP1208-4 Professional Consulting Services Schedule D – Contract Options

This example of Schedule D for LGP1208-4 Professional Consulting Services highlights the different options that can be applied based on the value of the procurement.

Under this panel arrangement, engagements will be classified under the **VendorPanel** following: Schedule D, Option 1 (*) or Option 2 (*) Level 1: Up to \$50,000 (incl. Option 3: AS4905-2002 or AS4906-2002 Recommended for Class 4 (Minor Construction Projects) \$150,000 to \$500,000 (excl. GST).	A copy of the AS contracts may be purchased through SAI Global. Refer to <u>AS4905-2002</u> or <u>AS4906-2002</u>
